One item of importance that was shared with the group.

AB 5 the new law defining employees is likely the biggest based on the Dynamex case- A,B,C test to determine if independent contractor or employee and the [Precision Framing Systems, Inc. v. Luzuriaga](#)- case advising of the perils or recording a mechanic's lien before completed with work (or if go back and do more work after initially completing work). The [Precision Framing Systems, Inc. v. Luzuriaga](#)- case the contractor thought they were done with work and recorded a lien- general contractor agreed contractor was finished. Later after an architect's inspection they were requested to go back and complete work to address correction notices which the contractor did and the court ruled that the lien recorded before doing the correction work was invalid because they had not completed their work to have a valid lien claim.

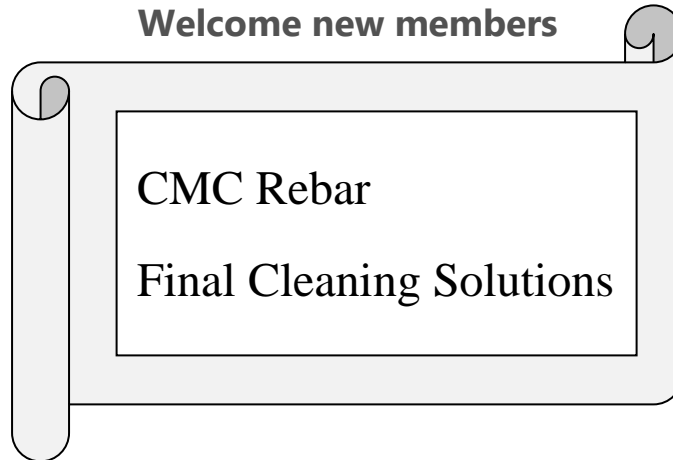
